On June 23, 2002 departed our ranks the Commander of Post 98, Stanley Bednarczyk.

Stanley was born on May 20, 1916 in New Haven, Connecticut, five years after his parents immigrated from Poland. His whole life was dedicated to service for our Polish community and the Polish Parish of St. Stanislaus in New Haven, where he first attended the Polish Parochial School and was later one of the founders and past president of the Holy Name Society. He was also past president of the Chopin Dramatic Club.

Stanley was a US. Army Veteran, serving in both the Pacific and European theaters. He entered active military service in March, 1941 and, after his basic

training, arrived in New Guinea with Battery A, 238th AAA Searchlight Battalion where he served for two and one-half years. After a brief return to the United States in late 1944 he departed for Europe and arrived in France in January, 1945. Assigned to Company 1, 291st Regiment of the 2nd Infantry Division, he took part in the Battle of the Bulge in the Ardennes Forest.

In August, 1945 he was discharged from active duty and was awarded the Bronze Star, the Combat Infantry Badge and the Asiatic Pacific and European Theater Campaign Ribbons.

Following his military duty, he settled in New Haven, Connecticut, attended the University of New Haven, and retired from Pratt & Whitney Aircraft after 28 years of service as a group supervisor. He was also a member and one of the organizers at the Stempik Post 162 of the American Legion in New Haven.

Stanley is survived by his wife Sophie, his son Thomas, his daughter Noreen, his brother Casimir, six grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.

He will be missed by all of us.
